Liza — with a Z, of course — got married last night in front of a full complement of A- and B-list celebs at a Robert Goulet-meets-The Doobie Brothers paparazzi extravaganza.

"I do! I do!" Liza exclaimed at the altar.

For weeks, the no-last-nameneeded crowd had been looking forward to this one: Liza Minnelli, everyone's favorite back-from-

the-brink performer, getting hitched to producer-promoter David Gest.

Liza's fourth shot at nuptial bliss was hyped as the wedding of the century even though many of the 800 guests clearly were relics of the previous century, among them Gale Storm, Anne Jeffries, Donny Osmond, Hasselhoff David and Joan Collins.

#### On Fifth Ave.

Liz Taylor and Minnelli's "Cabaret" costar Marisa Berenson were the maids of honor. The 15 bridesmaids, all in black, included Gina Lollobrigida, Esther Williams and Petula Clark.

An endless string cluding one shared the wedding scene. by Taylor, Jackson and Diana Ross,

pulled up outside the Marble Collegiate Church on Fifth Ave. at 29th

Carol Channing played the role of everywoman, rolling up in a yellow cab and waving to the crowd.

Longtime Liza fan Michael LaRusso couldn't still his racing heart as the flamboyant parade swept into the church.

"I hope she's happy with this man and it lasts for her," said LaRusso, 47, of Staten Island.

Minnelli, 56, wore an off-theshoulder ivory sequined gown with a long train by Bob Mackie. Insiders swore Gest, 48, couldn't keep his eyes off the bride.

"They were kissing through the whole ceremony," one guest said.

Jackson had trouble opening the box holding the wedding ring.

He turned for help to Taylor, who has had seven husbands, and she popped it right open.

Whitney Houston was supposed to sing "The Greatest Love," but she bagged it. So Natalie Cole war-

bled "Unforgettable" instead.

After the ceremony, the limousines rolled down to the Regent Hotel on Wall St. Minnelli donned a white fur coat and changed into a knee-length red sequined dress for the party.
